Enhancements

Ad-Hoc Updates

A new link called Non-Public SSID Management has been added to the Ad-Hoc
Updates screen. Administrators for non-public districts can click this link to open the new
Non-Public SSID Management screen to bulk assign SSIDs. Administrators can now
auto-assign SSIDs to students in non-public schools using their four character
state-assigned prefix. (ProgressBook StudentInformation Ad-Hoc Updates Guide)

Edit Student Profile

On the Edit Student Profile screen Additional tab, with a student in context, you can
now add or edit a Non-Public SSID. The district SSID prefix displays in the District's
Non-Public SSID Prefix field. Only new Non-Public SSID numbers may be entered. If
you enter a Non-Public SSID already assigned to another student, a message requesting
a different Non-Public SSID displays. (ProgressBook StudentInformation Student and

Pre-Identification Export

- On the Pre-Identification Export screen, when you create an export file for Pre-Ident
 For AASWD and OCBA HS Export, the file will exclude students who do not have an
 SSID or a Non-Public SSID. If a non-public district is in context, and some students have
 not been assigned a Non-Public SSID, a message displays instructing you to access the
 Student Profile Edit screen to edit the Non-Public SSID on the Additional Tab.

- On the Pre-Identification Export screen, when you create an export file for Pre-Ident
 For AASWD and OCBA 3-8 Export, the file will exclude students who do not have an
 SSID or a Non-Public SSID. If a non-public district is in context, and some students have
 not been assigned a Non-Public SSID, a message displays instructing you to access the
 Student Profile Edit screen to edit the Non-Public SSID on the Additional Tab.

Resolved Issues

Pre-Identification Export

- (D10715) Previously, on the Pre-Identification Export screen, if you ran the Pearson Educational Measurement Export, some students registered as JVS, Contract Vocational Out, or Contract Vocational In were erroneously excluded from the report. The report now includes JVS and Contract Vocational In/Out students when the appropriate check box is selected.
- (D10709) Previously, on the Pre-Identification screen, when you created an export file
 for Pre-Ident For AASWD and OCBA HS Export, the file excluded JVS students with
 zero FTE, even though the check box for JVS students was selected. Now, the OCBA HS
 Export File correctly includes selected students.

EZ Query, EMIS

(D10746) Previously, when you generated a report on the EZ Query screen or an EMIS extract on the EMIS screen, you could send the downloaded report link to another user, who could then open the report without a security password. Now when you share a report link with other users, they must log in to the ProgressBook site in order to access the report.
