### **Enhancements**

## **Staff/Course Transfer - Collection (L)**

Previously, for College Credit Plus courses, when transferring staff and course data using
the Transfer-Staff Course (CU) option on the Staff/Course Transfer - Collection (L)
screen, staff credentials were reported as 999999999. The correct State Staff ID value is
now included in the file for local school district teachers contracted by a college to teach
CCP.

## **Assessment Imports**

- On the Assessment Imports screen, When you select OCBA from the Assessment
  Type drop-down list, the following message displays: AASCD Test Results will not be
  imported in Student Information at this time.
- Beginning in FY16, you can import scores for all assessment subject areas in Next Generation Assessments and End of Course Assessments. These are included in the OCBA import file, when you select OCBA from the Assessment Type drop-down list on the Assessment Imports screen.

**Note:** Each test subject is listed with the name of the **Assessment** screen: **Next Generation Assessment Grades 3-8** or **End of Course Exam**.

- Imported OCBA test data now includes results for non-public school students. StudentInformation matches test data to the student's Non-Public SSID.
- When importing OCBA files, a new metric, Performance Level, is now imported for each assessment.

### **Next Generation Assessment Grades 3-8**

- A new optional field, Performance Level, has been added to the Add Assessment
  Result window of the Next Generation Assessment Grades 3-8 screen. Select one of
  five options that describe the performance level of the student.
- A new assessment, 03REA Grade 3 Reading Promotion, has been added to the Assessment Area drop-down list on the Add Assessment Result window of the Next Generation Assessment Grades 3-8 screen.
- A new field, Grade 3 Reading Promotion Status, has been added to the Add Assessment Result window. This option is available only when 03REA - Grade 3

**Reading Promotion** is the selected **Assessment Area**. Select one of three options for the promotion status: **Yes**, **No**, or blank.

- (E10636) Previously, all accommodations on the Add Assessment Result window defaulted to No, and the administrator had to manually change the field. The accommodations for Grade 3 Reading Promotion assessment now load automatically from OCBA to the import file.
- The scores for Next Generation Assessment Grades 3-8, as well as Grade 3 reading proficiency, are now reported in the GN Transfer.

#### **Edit Student Profile**

 The FN-Attributes tab on the Edit Student Profile screen now reports the most recent value for the Third Grade Reading Promotion Status (Yes/No) as recorded on the Next Generation Assessment Grades 3-8 screen.

#### **End of Course Exam**

- A new optional field, Performance Level, has been added to the Add Assessment Result window of the End of Course Exam screen. Select one of five options that describe the performance level of the student.
- When the home school district imports an End of Course assessment record for a JVS student, the home building IRN is imported as \*\*\*\*\*\*.
- Previously, only the home school could import End of Course Assessment records for JVS students. With this release, the JVS district can now import End of Course Assessment records for JVS students.
- The scores for End of Course assessments are reported in the GE Transfer.

# **Pre-Identification Export**

 (D10878) Upon exporting the Pre-Ident For OLSAT Export file on the Pre-Identification Export screen, the OLSAT export file displayed data in OGT format instead of in OLSAT format. This has been fixed.
