CTE Student Assessment (OCTCA)

- (E11133) The OCTCA import file has been updated to accept new assessment areas added to the **CTE Student Assessment (OCTCA)** screen for **School Year 2015-2016** and **2016-2017**. The five new assessment areas are now included when you import **OCTCA** records. You can also manually add the new codes to a student's **OCTCA** assessment record:
 - 02MD - Business and Administrative Services
 - 18MD - Visual Design and Imaging
 - 19MD - Media Arts
 - 36MD - Marketing
 - 38MD - Performing Arts

Special Education Import (SpS)

- The FE Import on the **Special Education Import (SpS)** screen, with option **Student Special Education Graduation Requirement (FE)** selected, now transfers test values/requirements for OGT (GX) and End of Course (GE) to the **Student Special Education** screen **Grad Requirement** tab.

ACT

- (E10716) On the **Student Assessment Menu ACT** screen, the range for the **Writing Subject Score** has been updated to allow numbers 1–36 to be entered.

SAT Reasoning Test

- (E10893) The **Student Assessment Menu SAT Reasoning Test** screen, has been updated to have two subsections: **Pre - 2016 SAT Reasoning Scores** and **Redesigned SAT Reasoning Scores** (for entering test scores from FY 2016 and later).

- (E10893) On the **SAT Reasoning Test Scores** screen, new tool tips have been added to tell you the EMIS code for each score when adding and editing the **Critical Reading Score, Math Score, and Writing Score** for **Pre - 2016 SAT Reasoning** tests, and when adding or editing the **Evidence-Based Reading and Writing Section Score** and **Math Section Score** for **Redesigned SAT Reasoning** tests (3/1/16 and later).

Assessment Imports

- (E10893) On the **Assessment Imports** screen, in the **Assessment Type** drop-down menu, selecting **SAT (Old Format)** lets you import SAT records dated prior to October 2015. Selecting **Redesigned SAT** lets you import SAT records dated October 2015 and later. (*ProgressBook StudentInformation Assessment Guide*)
- On the **Assessment Imports** screen, in the **Assessment Type** drop-down menu, selecting **OCBA** lets you import **AASCD (Alternate Assessments)** test results. The import process imports grades 3-8 alternate assessment results to the **OAA** assessment maintenance screen (**Student Achievement**), and the high school alternate assessment results to the **OGT** assessment maintenance screen. Additionally, on the **OGT** and **Student Achievement** screens, the **OCBA Alternate Import** now reports **ELA** assessments as two reports: **Reading** and **Writing**.

Assessment Reporting Collection A and Graduate Reporting Period (G)

- (E10893) On the **EMIS Assessment Reporting Collection A** and **Graduate Reporting Period (G)** screens, the **EMIS Transfer, SAT (SA)**, now reports two assessment scores coded as **R** for **Evidence-Based Reading and Writing** and **M** for **Math**, which correspond with the new **SAT Reasoning Test** taken after 3/1/16. For **SAT Reasoning Tests** taken before 3/1/16, the **SAT EMIS Transfer** continues to report three assessment scores coded as **R** for **Critical Reading**, **M** for **Math**, and **W** for **Writing**.

Resolved Issues

Assessment Reporting Collection (A)

- (D11132) Previously, when you installed **StudentInformation v15.3.5, End of Course (GE)** and **Next Generation Assessment Grades 3-8 (GN)**, assessments did not transfer correctly because School Year ID did not correlate correctly to the fiscal year of the assessment date. This hot fix v15.3.6 corrects the script, and End of Course and Next Generation assessment records now assign School Year ID according to fiscal year of test date, allowing the transfer to run correctly.

Assessment Imports

- (D11157) Previously, the **OCBA** import saved some assessment results with a Form Type of **ST1** and **ST2**, and disallowed results without either **PBA** or **EOY**. This has been changed, and all **OCBA** records now save with a Form Type of **STR**.
