

StudentInformation v16.0.0 provides several new features and resolves some issues to improve your experience. This overview explains the recent changes.

Enhancements

User Interface

- The StudentInformation user interface has been restyled to be consistent with other ProgressBook Suite applications. The StudentInformation landing page, as well as buttons and icons throughout the application, have been updated to improve navigation and usability. Most functionality remains the same, with the exception of the enhancements listed below.

Edit Student Profile

- The tabs on this screen have been updated to improve readability and usability.

Student Requests and Assignments

- A new **Run Scheduler** button has been added to enable student scheduling from this screen.

Family Groups

- When a student is re-registered and re-activated in a family group, the courier is reset according to the option selected on the **District Options** screen.

Transcript Formatter (R702) and Schedule Card Formatter (R701)

- After creating a schedule card or transcript, on the **Load Settings** tab, you can select **Private** to make the report unavailable on the **I Want To...** menu, or select **Available in I Want To Menu** to list the report on the **I Want To...** menu.

Note: *This setting cannot be changed. The report must be deleted and re-created to change the privacy setting.*

EMIS Run Requests

- Previously, the **Reporting Collection G Student Assessment** report included all assessments. Now, each assessment can be run separately, and an additional assessment has been added for **End of Course Exam**.

I Want To...

- With a student in context, you can now view and print student transcripts and student schedules from the **I Want To...** menu. (*ProgressBook StudentInformation Getting Started Guide*)

School Absences and Daily Absence List

- With a student in context, you can now add multiple absences over a date range if they have the same **Absence Type** code, **Absence Level**, **Reason**, and **Note**.
- You can now add and view daily absences that are outside of the Master Calendar Range.
- On the **Daily Absence List** screen, you can now search for students within the building and add absences for these students.
 - Enter the student's name or student number into the **Add Absence Event** field. A search entry of at least three characters will display a list of student names or student numbers that match the inquiry.

Student Medical Defaults

- A new screen, **Student Medical Defaults**, is accessible at the building level. You can now assign defaults to the following health screenings found on the **Student Medical Records** menu:
 - **Growth Screening Defaults: Set Default Blood Pressure**
 - **Health Log Defaults: Set Default Location and Default Care By**
 - **Hearing Screening Defaults: Set Left/Right Ear Default**
 - **Scoliosis Screening Defaults: Set Default Result Code**
 - **Vision Screening Defaults: Set Default Right Eyesight/Left Eyesight, Set Default Muscle Balance Near/Far**

Growth Screening

- (E2431) With a student in context, you can now add blood pressure measurements and enter comments up to 500 characters. Student **Height** and **Weight** fields are now required, and entering these values will auto-calculate the body mass index, **BMI**, for the student.

Note: *BMI field cannot be edited.*

Health Log

- The **Reason for Visit** field has added options of **Injury**, **Illness**, and **Other** in the drop-down list. A new **Reason Comments** field has been added, and both **Reason Comments** and **Comments** fields now allow up to 500 characters.

Hearing Screening

- **Left Ear/Right Ear** fields display the preset defaults. You can also enter comments up to 500 characters.

Scoliosis Screening

- The **Result Code** displays the preset default of **Pass**, and the **Comments** field has been enhanced to allow up to 500 characters.

Vision Screening

- (E2431) With a student in context, you can now enter results for **Muscle Balance Near** and **Muscle Balance Far**. Using the drop-down list, select **Pass**, **Fail**, or **Not Applicable**. You can also set these as default values on the **Student Medical Defaults** screen. You can enter comments up to 500 characters.

Medical Immunization

- When you add or edit an immunization record, the **Comment** field now allows up to 500 characters.

Dental Screening

- When you add or edit a screening, the **Special Services Rendered** and **Findings** comment fields now allow up to 500 characters.

Student Medication

- When you add or edit a medication, the **Comment** field now allows up to 500 characters.

Medical Alerts

- With a student in context, you can now add **Private Notes** for a **Medical Alert Condition**. The **Private Notes** are not sent to **GradeBook**. Comment fields for **Medical Alert Condition** and **Private Notes** have also been enhanced to allow up to 500 characters.
- Only **Active** medical alerts with current **Starting Date** and **Ending Date** are sent to **Gradebook**.

Student Data Tasks

- This screen has been optimized for faster operation.

Resolved Issues

Report Card Formatter (R700)

- (D3003) Previously, when running reports for Report Card Formatter (R700), students in specific memberships, but not current year members, appeared in the results. All reports for Report Card Formatter (R700) now only pull students with the membership in the current year.

Student Eligibility Details

- (D8882) Previously, course codes longer than six characters were not recognized when a course element was included in a graduation rule. The **Student Eligibility Details** screen will now recognize course codes with up to 15 characters.

View Profile

- (D10936) Previously, when a student was withdrawn, any associated family group was deleted the same day from the **Student View Profile** screen, even though the student remains active in the family group until the next day. The family group can now be seen on the **View Profile** screen until the end of day of the withdrawal.

Family Groups

- (D8539) Previously, when a student was promoted to a future school year, the incorrect grade level displayed on the **Family Groups** screen **Students** tab. Now the correct grade level displays on the **Family Groups** screen.
