Enhancements

Grad Points Summary

- (E11937) The **Social Studies Credits** details screen now displays the student's requirements and progress toward American History and American Government credits. Students must complete three credits in Social Studies; students graduating in 2018 and 2019 must complete at least 0.5 credits of American History and 0.5 credits of American Government; students graduating in 2021, in addition to the above requirements, must also complete at least 0.5 credits of World History and Civilizations.

Ad-Hoc Reports

- New functionality now supports FTP transfers of Ad-Hoc Reports. The supported transfer types include FTP (unsecure), SFTP, FTP Implicit TLS, and FTP Explicit TLS.

Resolved Issues

Grad Points Summary

- (D11934) Previously, when a student took a year-long course, the student did not receive any graduation points credit after completing the first semester and only received full credit after completing the course in the second semester. Now, when a student takes a year-long course, the student earns partial credit after each reporting period (such as a semester/trimester/quarter) within the year, and earns the remaining credit after completing the final reporting period of the year. For example, if a year long course has two final (earned) marks in the marking pattern, the student only receives half the credit at the end of the first semester, and receives the second half of the credit at the end of the second semester.

Student Profile

- (D12025) Previously, users who did not have the proper permissions were able to reassign student numbers on the **Edit Student Profile** screen. Now, only users who have the proper permissions can reassign student numbers.
- (D12025) Previously, users who were not granted permission to Reassign Student Numbers could not **View/Print Student Transcripts** from the **I want to...** drop-down list

in the student context box. Now, in these circumstances, users can **View/Print Transcripts** accordingly.

School Absences

- (D11853) Previously, when you entered an absence over a date range that included non-attending days (such as weekends), the added absence only included the start date of the range. Now, in these circumstances, the date range of the absence saves correctly.

Daily Absence List

- (D11907) Previously, when you edited an absence with an **Absence Level** of **AM Absence** or **PM Absence**, it automatically switched the **Absence Level** to **Full Absence**. Now, in these circumstances, the **Absence Level** remains the same.

Enhancements

Civil Rights Reporting

- (E11671) The following changes to part one of the Civil Rights reporting for the 2015-2016 school year and forward are now available in StudentInformation.
 - You can now access part one of the report from the **Civil Rights Report** screen. Part two will be available at a later date.
 - The part one report has a new layout that includes new required tables and subsections, updated table names, and new table totals. The section below details the new tables and major updates to certain tables.

 - Student Enrollment in Science Classes – Now includes additional subject codes.
 - Dual Enrollment Programs – These programs are now determined by the **Dual Credit** check box on the **Course** record for Course Section Assignments for students. Previously, this indicator was populated based on information on the **Additional Civil Rights Data Collection** screen.

- Single-Sex Academic Classes – Now includes additional subject codes, Advanced Placement (AP) courses, and International Baccalaureate (IB) courses.
- The **Effective Date** functionality now defaults to 10/1 of the school year in context. Once you have submitted a report, the **Effective Date** functionality saves and defaults to the previously submitted report date. Regardless of whether you submitted a report, you can select a reporting date between 9/27 and 12/31 of the school year in context.
- The **Additional Civil Rights Data Collection** and **Civil Rights Report** screens now have improved user interfaces.
- The **Additional Civil Rights Data Collection** screen now includes additional prompts for users complete to support the report. Below are new tables derived from the **Additional Civil Rights Data Collection** screen:
 - Teachers - FTE Count and Certification
 - Teacher Years of Experience
 - Current Year and Previous Year Teachers
 - School Counselors
 - Security Staff
 - Support Services Staff
