Enhancements

Assessment Extract

- (E11080) The new **Assessment Extract** screen on the **Assessment Menu** lets districts extract test results from multiple assessments for one or more students into a single file to be transferred to another district. (*ProgressBook StudentInformation Assessment Guide*)

Assessment Imports

- (E11080) On the **Assessment Imports** screen, you can now import files from the **Assessment Extract** screen. (*ProgressBook StudentInformation Assessment Guide*)

Ad-Hoc Reports

- When you create ad-hoc reports using SFTP and FTP, you can now designate a remote file name in the **Output File Prefix** field.
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Resolved Issues

Ad-Hoc Reports

- (D12061) Previously, when an ad-hoc report contained a join that returned an excessive amount of rows, the web server sometimes crashed. Now, ad-hoc report results are limited to 20,000 rows by default to avoid this crash. Each ITC can modify this limit.

Graduation Points

- (D12125) Previously, on the **Grad Points Summary** screen, in the **Graduation Pathways** section, when a student completed a total of 18 or more points on the **State Assessment** pathway but did not meet each individual subject requirement (e.g., 4 points in Math), the summary incorrectly displayed the student's progress as **Complete**. Now, in these circumstances, the student's **State Assessment** pathway displays as **In Progress**.

Edit Student Profile

- (D11933) Previously, when you edited a student's FS record to add an SSID, an error occurred with a general message indicating that the SSID was already assigned to another student. Now, when a conflict of assigned SSIDs occur, the message indicates the student to which the SSID is assigned.
- (D6069) Previously, when you edited and saved an SSID to a student's **FS-Standing** tab, it incorrectly saved the SSID to the **tbiStudent**, which is no longer used. Now, the FS record correctly saves the SSID to **tbiStudentEMISFS**.

State Student ID Import

- (D10726) Previously, when you imported SSIDs, the **Last Modified** field on the **Edit Student Profile** screen did not always reflect the latest import date and time. Now, the **Last Modified** field displays the correct date and time.

Bulk Enroll Pending Students

- (D10456) Previously, when you performed a bulk enrollment that included transferring multiple students' assessment and attendance records, the transferred assessment and attendance data did not always correspond to the correct student. Now, in these circumstances, students and their assessment and attendance records transfer correctly.
- (D6628) Previously, when you performed a bulk enrollment that transferred a student from one district with a future year in context to another district with a future year in context, the student's SSID did not copy over to the receiving school's FS record. Now, in these circumstances, the student's SSID transfers correctly.

Home School Import

- (D11914,6067) Previously, the Home School Import referred to the deprecated **tbiStudent.StateStudentId** for the student's SSID, which is no longer used, and resulted in a "Student Not Found" error. Now, the Home School Import correctly refers to **tbiStudentEMISFS.StateStudentId** to match the student's SSID.

Special Education

- (D11294) Previously, on the **Special Education** screen **Grad Requirement** tab, records without a UserID did not display. Now, in these circumstances, the records display correctly.

Transcript Formatter (R702)

- (D11250) Previously, when students had summer withdrawal dates, the withdrawal dates did not print on the transcripts. Now in these circumstances, the withdrawal dates print correctly.

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Enhancements

Student Success

- (E11982) The **ThinkGate Extract Maintenance** screen has been renamed the **Student Success Export Maintenance** screen.
- (E11982) On the **School Demographics** screen, the **ThinkGate School Type** field header has been renamed the **Student Success School Type**. (*ProgressBook StudentInformation School Year Setup and Configuration Guide*)
- (E11982) All text fields in the .csv export are now in double quotes to ensure accurate data loading by the vendor.

Civil Rights Reporting

- (E11890) The following changes to part two of the Civil Rights reporting for the 2015-2016 school year and forward are now available in StudentInformation.
 - You can now access part two of the report from the **Civil Rights Report** screen.
 - The part two report has a new layout that includes new required tables, subsections, and new table totals. The section below details the new tables and major updates to certain tables.

- (E12001) The **Additional Civil Rights Data Collection** screen now has an additional **Save** button at the bottom of the screen for users to save while entering data at the bottom portion instead of needing to scroll back up to the top.

Resolved Issues

Civil Right Reporting Part One

- (D12079) Previously, on the **Additional Civil Rights Data Collection** screen, for the **Alternative School Detail** and **Justice Facility Type** table options, when schools selected “No,” in the generated .csv file, the corresponding data cells incorrectly generated as “No.” Now, in these circumstances, the data cells correctly generate as blanks.
- (D12087) Previously, on the **Additional Civil Rights Data Collection** screen, the fields for the **FTE Count and Certification**, **Teacher Year of Experience**, **Current Year and Previous Year Teachers**, **School Counselors**, **Security Staff**, and **Support Services Staff** tables did not allow users to enter numbers higher than 99.99. Now, users may enter numbers up to 10,000.00 in these fields.
- (D12083) Previously, students in memberships with code 235012 or 235013 did not populate the **Students enrolled in LEP Programs** row as expected in the **Enrollment of**

Limited English Proficiency Students table of the Civil Rights Report Part One. Now, in these circumstances, the students are included correctly.

- (D12114) Previously, students enrolled in multiple dual credit courses were incorrectly counted more than once in overall ethnicity. Now, in these circumstances, the students are only counted once.
- (D12106) Previously, on the **Additional Civil Rights Data Collection** screen, on the **Current Year and Previous Year Teachers** table, the question prompts were “Number of current school year teachers” and “Number of previous school year teachers.” Now, the question prompts are “Teachers employed during current school year” and “Teachers employed during both the current and previous school years” to match new federal requirements.
- (D12131) Previously, the **Gifted and Talented Education Programs** indicator incorrectly returned **No** when there were students identified as gifted and served in the current reporting year. Now, in these circumstances, the table correctly returns **Yes**.

Civil Right Reporting Part Two

- (D12030) Previously, the suspension/expulsion data for the FY13/14 Civil Rights Report Part Two had duplication issues. Now, the Part Two report for FY13/14 and forward include data correctly.

Civil Right Reporting Parts One and Two

- (D12065) Previously, when multiple buildings in a district had the same IRN, an error occurred when you ran Civil Rights Report Part One or Part Two. Now, in these circumstances, the reports run without error.
- (D12065) Previously, when multiple buildings in a district had the same IRN, the data for these buildings did not combine properly in the .csv file. Now, in these circumstances, the data combines correctly.
