Resolved Issues

Civil Rights Reporting Part Two

- (D12177) Previously, certain tables in part two incorrectly used the last day of the school year to include students. Now, users must select an **Effective Date** for part two (which should be the same as the **Effective Date** selected for part one) to correctly calculate the data. This date is used to include students for the following tables:
 - Students who Passed Algebra I in Grade 7
 - Students who Passed Algebra I in Grade 8
 - High School Students who Passed Algebra I
 - Student Participation in Advanced Placement (AP) exams
 - Students who Received a Qualifying Score on Advanced Placement (AP) Exams
 - (D12186) Chronic Student Absenteeism

Next Generation Assessment Grades 3-8

- (D12179) Previously, on a student's **Next Generation Assessment Grade 3-8** maintenance screen, when you edited an **English Language Arts** or **3rd Grade Reading Promotion** record with **Fall Block** selected as the **Period of Test** and ran the Period A transfer process, the month specified for the **Period of Test** on the transferred record file incorrectly changed to **12** (December) instead of remaining as **11** (November). Now, in these circumstances, the month on the **Period of Test** does not change in the generated file.

Note: *In the upgrade files, a script is included to correct all records that were affected by this issue.*
