

V17.0.1 RELEASE NOTES

StudentInformation v17.0.1 provides several new features and resolves some issues to improve your experience. This overview explains the recent changes.

Enhancements

StateReporting

UNCLEMIS

- (E12312) From FY17 and forward, the Student Demographic Verification (UNCLEMIS) process now ensures that students do not have both a Withdraw Reason of 35 and a Sent to 1 Reason or Sent to 2 Reason code of AU, CE, CR, CT, FP, JP, JV, MR, OS, PI, or PP. If a student has both criteria, you receive the error message: "FS34E [effective date of incorrect FS record] ERROR: Student cannot have withdrawal code 35 when Sent to 1 or 2 AU, CE, CR, CT, FP, JP, JV, MR, OS, PI, PP."
- (E12312) From FY17 and forward, the Student Demographic Verification (UNCLEMIS) process now ensures that when a student has a Withdraw Reason of 35, their District of Residence IRN matches their current district. If the District of Residence IRN does not match their current district, you receive the error message: "FS35E [effective date of incorrect FS record] ERROR: Non-Resident Student cannot be withdrawn when Withdrawn Reason = 35."
- (E12312) From FY17 and forward, the Student Demographic Verification (UNCLEMIS) process now ensures that if a student has a **District Relationship** of 1 or 2, you receive the error message: "FS36E [effective date of incorrect FS record] ERROR: Withdrawal reason 35 should only be reported when the District Relationship value = 3."
- (E11701) From FY17 and forward, when the Student Demographic Verification
 (UNCLEMIS) process assesses errors FN19E, FN20E, and FN21E, it now compares the
 corresponding Third Grade Reading Guarantee Math Diagnostic Result Code, Reading
 Diagnostic Result Code, or Writing Diagnostic Result Code of each student with the
 State Equivalent Grade of that student at the start of the school year instead of the State
 Equivalent Grade of that student at the date the verification process is run.
- (E11766) From FY17 and forward, the Student Demographic Verification (UNCLEMIS) SMART error for the **Attending Building IRN** now allows any valid Building or District IRN for the district in context.

Assessment Transfer - Collection (A)

- From FY17 and forward, the Period A Transfer WorkKeys (WK) now includes all WorkKeys assessments regardless of the date they were taken.
- From FY17 and forward, the Period A **Transfer SAT (SA)** now includes the selected **Score Not Reported** value for each record; when the **Score Not Reported** value is neither * nor blank, any existing scores in the record are indicated as *** in the transfer file.
- From FY17 and forward, the Period A Transfer ACT (AC) now includes the selected Score Not Reported value for each record. When an ACT assessment has existing scores of ***, they are reported with the Score Not Reported value; any other assessment areas with score values are not included in the transfer.

Graduate Reporting - Collection (G)

- From FY17 and forward, the Period G Transfer SAT (SA) now includes the selected Score Not Reported value for each record; when the Score Not Reported value is neither * nor blank, any existing scores in the record are indicated as *** in the transfer file.
- From FY17 and forward, the Period A Transfer ACT (AC) now includes the selected Score Not Reported value for each record. When an ACT assessment has existing scores of ***, they are reported with the Score Not Reported value; any other assessment areas with score values are not included in the transfer.

ACT

 From FY17 and forward, when you add or edit an ACT record, in the Score Not Reported drop-down list, you can now select 3 - Already met remediation free standards or 4 - English Learner - Less than 2 years in US schools and no accommodations available.

SAT

From FY17 and forward, when you add or edit an SAT record, in the Score Not Reported drop-down list, you can now select 3 - Already met remediation free standards or 4 - English Learner - Less than 2 years in US schools and no accommodations available.

StudentInformation

Advanced Student Search

 (D12339) Previously, on the Advanced Student Search screen Search All Years tab, the State Student Id (SSID) field only applied to the current school year. Now, it applies to all school years.

Course Fees

• (D9223,6368) A script has been included in the release to correct fee proration assignments for the new FY18 school year.

StateReporting

WorkKeys

• (D12310) Previously, the **WorkKeys** screen only accepted dates from Feb–May and Aug–Nov. Now, the **WorkKeys** screen accepts dates from every month of the year.

SAT

 (D12333) Previously, when you added or edited SAT assessments with a Score Not Reported option other than * - Not Applicable, Student took the Test, you were unable to enter *** as a valid score for any subject. Now, you can enter a score of ***.

Note: SAT scores with a value of *** display as 0 for Graduation Points.

ACT

 (D12332) Previously, when you added or edited ACT assessments with a Score Not Reported option other than * - Not Applicable, Student took the Test, you were unable to enter *** as a valid score for any subject. Now, you can enter a score of ***.

Note: ACT scores with a value of *** display as 0 for Graduation Points.

OCTCA

- (D12340) Previously, when you imported OCTCA assessment records with the codes 34MD and 40MD, the records incorrectly saved to both OCTCA and Industry Credential. Now, in these circumstances, the records save correctly to OCTCA only.
- (D12340) A script has been included in the release to remove records that were previously and incorrectly assigned to Industry Credential.
