Enhancements

StudentInformation

Analytics Hub

• When you run an Analytics Hub report, the screen now indicates that it is loading prior to reaching the filtering screen.

Assessment Import History

 (E11220) You can no longer delete assessment import history information. Records for deleted assessment result imports display on this screen. (ProgressBook StudentInformation Assessment Guide)

Attendance Calculator

 A new tblAttendanceTrackingReportingTermSummary table has been added and is populated with the SchoolYearld, StudentId, SchoolId, and ReportingTerm.

• (E13741) In the **Progress Toward Career Readiness** drop-down list, **4 - Progress Toward Platinum level NCRC** is now available.

Assessment Imports

• (E13570) When you import AP Exam results, now only the current year's results are imported.

New School Year

• The 2019-2020 school year script is included in this release.

Attendance Skipped Student Report

• (D13649) Previously, the **Status** and **Grade** drop-down lists were slow to populate. Now, the performance of these fields has improved.

Bulk Student Transfer

- (D10133) Previously, on the Edit Student Profile screen General tab, the Verified With drop-down list selection was not copied to the new building after you transferred students. Now, the selection is retained.
- (D5799) Previously, the student transfer process did not recognize school districts with special characters in their names as valid districts for transferring students. Now, you can transfer students to districts with special characters in their names.

Fee Reports

 (D10265) Previously, the labels on the R108-A Student Fee Collection List report and the R108-C Student Fee Invoice report printed in alphabetical order by first name instead of last name. Now, they correctly print alphabetically by last name.

GradeBook Nightly Integration

 (D12950) Previously, partial absences did not display in GradeBook after saving and were not sent to StudentInformation. Now, the partial absences can be saved in GradeBook and display in StudentInformation.

Home School Import

(D12986) Previously, the Homeless Status on the Edit Student Profile screen
FD-Attributes tab defaulted to N when you registered a student via the Home School
Import screen Students tab. Now, the Homeless Status defaults to *. A script has been
included in this release that updates N to * for this field.

Outstanding Fees

• (D13519) Previously, the only fees displaying on this screen were **Course Fees**. Now, all fee types display on this screen.

School Year Initialization

(D13561) Previously, when the Is Out of School Suspension check box was selected
for an absence type in a previous school year, it did not stay selected in the current school
year when School Year Initialization was run. Now, for absence types in these
circumstances, the Is Out of School Suspension check box is selected in the current
school year.

Student Absence Intervention

 (D13583) Previously, when you printed an absence letter, the bookmark for [YearlyUnexcusedAbsenceDays] pulled the same value as the [YearlyExcusedAbsenceDays] bookmark. Now, the [YearlyUnexcusedAbsenceDays] bookmark pulls the correct value.

Teacher History Maintenance

(D12910) Previously, on the Start and Stop Dates tab, when you updated the date and
the success message displayed, an error message also displayed indicating that you
need to select at least one building to update. Now, in these circumstances, the error
message does not display.

StateReporting

AP Exam Scores

• (D13626) Previously, when you imported results for a student who had results for the same exam from previous years, the UserID on the imported record was incorrect. Now, in these circumstances, the UserID is correct.

Assessment Imports

• (D13802) With the release of StudentInformation v18.4.0, all instances of OCBA were updated to OST, including in the **Assessment Type** drop-down list; however, ODE did not change OCBA for the assessment type, so the import was incorrectly changed. Now, when you import OST results, the records import correctly with OCBA in the file.

Memberships

 (D13521) Previously, when you bulk added membership codes to students in a particular building, if students from another building were included in the list for the district, the membership code was assigned to those students for the building in context even though they did not attend that building. Now, when you bulk add membership codes to students, they are assigned only to students in the building in context.
