

Class Title: StudentInformation Admin Mobile Application

Class Description:

This class will instruct you the options available in the mobile application and how it might be used by school administrators.

Pre-Requisite:

In order for a StudentInformation user to view student profiles on the mobile app, the role(s) assigned to them must have the correct permissions enabled. Please refer to your security administrator if unable to use app.

Introduction:

The ProgressBook SIS Admin mobile app allows schools administrators to access the essential data necessary for making in-the-moment decisions about the students in their school even while away from their desk.

What you need to know: The mobile app allows the administrator to:

- Search for student(s) that exist in the administrator's school district.
- View a student's picture and important profile information.
- View the student's contact information.
- View the student's current course schedule.
- View the student's recent attendance history.
- View the student's course grades throughout the school year.
- Device integration which includes call and email initiation and integration with the device's mapping app.
- View a school's bell schedule.

Recommendations:

The mobile app will timeout, but it recommended that the user logout once done with the application. This secures data when the device in not in the presence of the user.

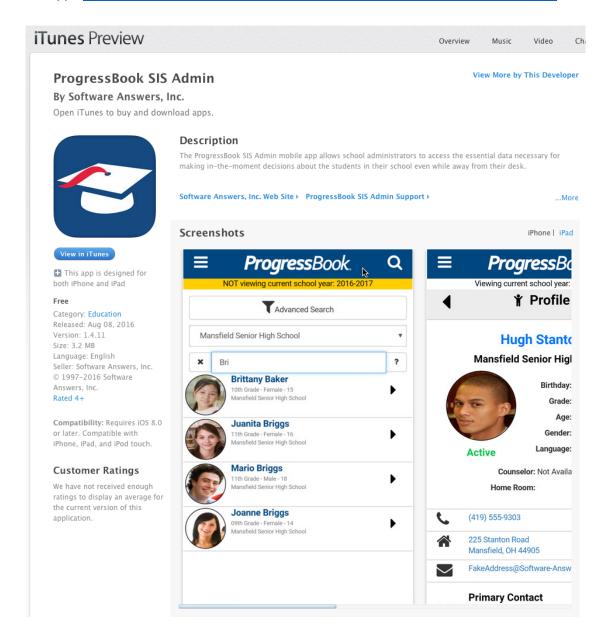

Objective 1 - Accessing the App

The ProgressBook SIS Admin Mobile App is a free application that can be downloaded from Google Play or the Apple App Store.

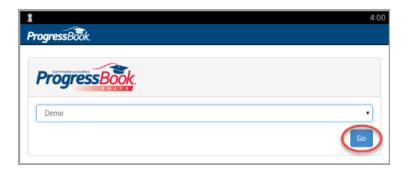

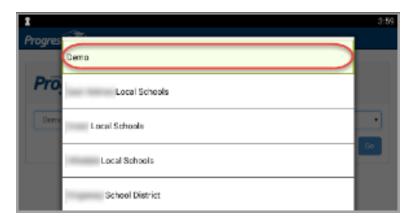


Objective 2 – Logging into the App

1. Once the app is opened on your device, tap the login screen will display.



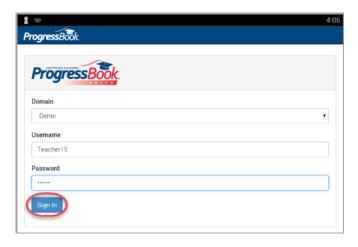
2. Select from the dropdown list, the district you need to log in to, then tap the Go button.





The mobile app is designed to support StudentInformation users that have access to a single district. Users that have access to multiple districts may experience degraded performance and/or unexpected results while using the app.

3. Enter your StudentInformation login credentials (same as the web version), then tap the Sign In button.



4. After Initializing ProgressBook App... completes, you will see a Welcome screen.







You will know the school year you are working with from the school year banner:

Viewing current school year: 2016-2017

5. The welcome Screen gives you two options: you can tap the in the upper left corner to go to the Other Options menu or tap in the upper right corner to go directly to the Search screen.

We will be going to the Other Options.

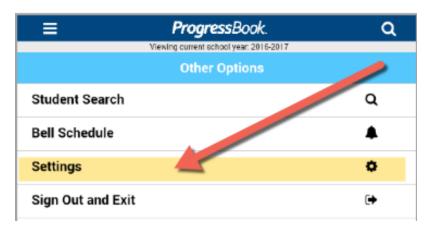


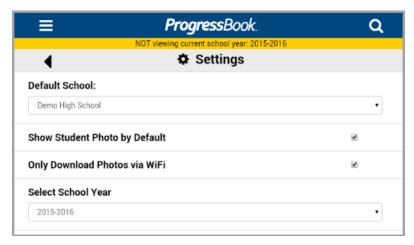
Objective 3 – Settings

The Other Options screen has 4 features here:

- Student Search Use to search for a particular student.
- Bell Schedule Use to view a school's bell schedule.
- Settings Configure available settings
- Sign Out and Exit Log out of the ProgressBook SIS Admin app

Before using the app, we should be familiar with how to change certain settings first. The settings screens will allow us to do that.





Default School (required) – Select the school used in context for app features.



When you log in, the app <u>always defaults to your selected default school in the StudentInformation</u> application. If you previously selected a different default school in the app, **this preference is not retained upon your subsequent login.**

• Show Student Photo by Default – Select this check box to display student photographs. De-select this check box to hide student photographs.



Only Download Photos via WiFi – Select this check box to download student photographs only via WiFi. De-select this
check box to download student photographs via 3G/4G or WiFi when needed.



If you select Show Student Photo by Default and Only Download Photos via WiFi, and are not connected to WiFi, student photographs do not display. Once you connect to WiFi, the student photographs display.

• Select School Year – To change which school year you are working in; you can choose another from the dropdown. It defaults to the current working school year.



When you log in, the app always uses the current date to determine the current school year as configured by your district. If you previously selected a different school year to use in context, **this preference is not retained upon your subsequent login.** If you select a non-current school year (15/16), the school year banner changes to yellow NOT viewing current school year: 2015-2016

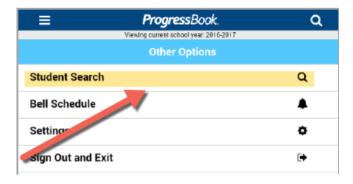
Settings are saved automatically - to go back to the Other Options, tap the Touch Menu icon in the upper left corner.



Objective 4 – Student Search

You can use the Student Search feature to look for particular students in a school. After locating a student, you can view their basic information: birthday, grade level, age, gender, language, counselor, home room, and contact details. You can also review a student's contacts, class schedule, attendance events, and grades.

NORMAL SEARCH



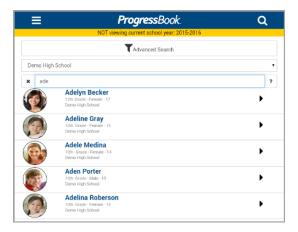
- On the Other Options screen, tap Student Search.
- 2. Select the school building in which you want to search from the drop-down list.



3. Next, in the Search for a student... text box, enter at least three letters of a student's first or last name to search for a student. The search results display instantly.



You can search by either first or last name; no reason to use full name because spaces are not recognized. Wildcards are not needed.







The search only displays a number of results that fit on one screen; if there are more results than can fit on one screen, the additional results do not display.

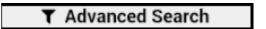


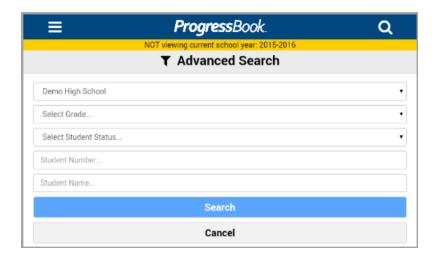
If you do not receive the results you are looking for, try entering more letters to narrow the search results or use Advanced Search (see below). Note: If you do not receive any search results or if specific students do not display in the search results, ensure the correct building and school year in context are selected (see Objective 3)

ADVANCED SEARCH

You can conduct an advanced search if you want to narrow the search results.

1. On the Student Search screen, tap Advanced Search.





You can select and enter any number of the parameters below.

- School (required) Select the school the student is in; defaults to your chosen.
- Select Grade... Select the student's grade level.
- Select Student Status... Select the student's status in the school.
- Student Number... Enter the student's ID number.
- Student Name... Enter first or last name.

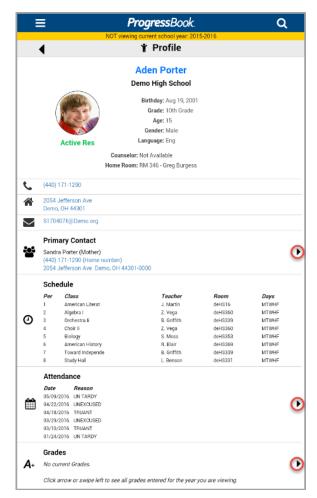


2. If you filter on grade 10 and student status A and tap Search, you will get a list of all 10th graders with an A status.



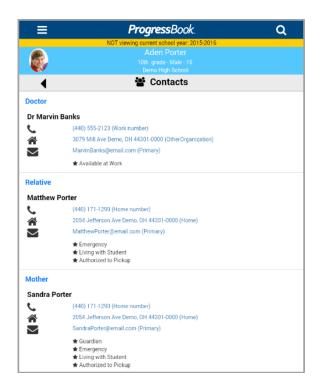
SELECT STUDENT PROFILE

1. Once using the search or advanced search, to select the student profile, tap a row of the student you would like to view.



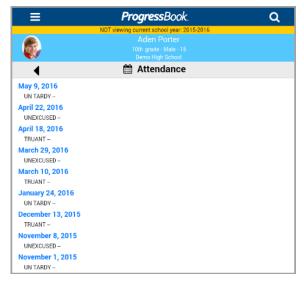


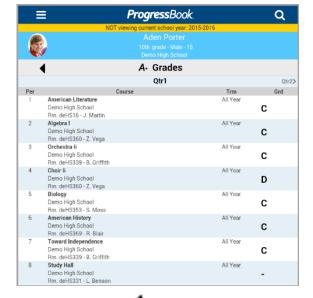
2. Optional: You can tap on the right of the screen or swipe left to see more details about a student's contacts, attendance, and grades.





You can tap on a contact's phone number to start a call, an address to map the location, and an email to start an email draft using your mobile device's default applications.





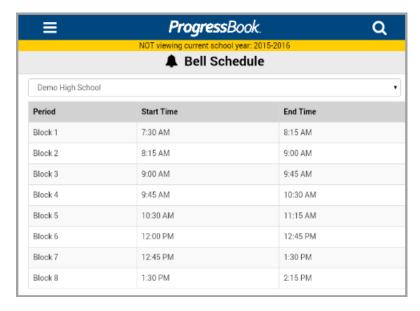
3. Optional: To return to the previous screen (e.g. Profile, Student Search), tap . To return to the Other Options screen, tap .



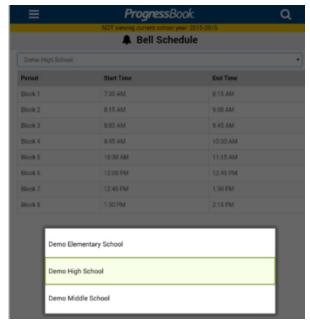
Objective 5 – Viewing Bell Schedule

You can view the bell schedule of all school buildings associated with your district.

1. On the Options screen, tap Bell Schedule; the bell schedule of your default school displays.



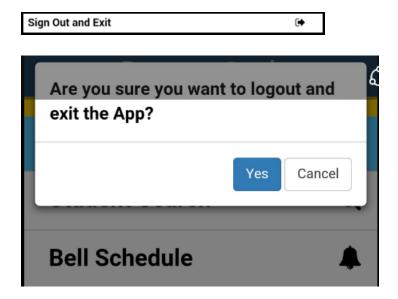
2. Optional: To view the bell schedule of a different school in your district, select the school from the drop-down list.



3. Optional: To return to the Other Options screen, tap \blacksquare .



Objective 6 – Logging out of App



1. You receive a confirmation – Are you sure you want to logout and exit the App Yes or Cancel?

If you tap Yes, you are signed out and exit the App.

If you tap Cancel, you go back to the Other Options
